#### My Latest.....by Joe XE X450

Saw a few videos of this flying machine and decided to purchase one. Best price was at Walmart by one of their third party sellers.

The package includes the plane(?). transmitter, one battery, a USB charger for the battery, spare props, a small screwdriver and instruction booklet. You need to supply 6 AA batteries for the transmitter.

The only issue out of the box was I had to calibrate the gyros as the plane wanted to slide to the left. Once calibrated, all was fine.



It has three basic modes, hover like a drone, vertical attitude (pointing straight up!), and fly like a plane. In the

plane mode, you can shut down certain gyros so you can perform loops, rolls, etc! It is quite zippy in the plane mode. So far, I done all except the aerobatic flying with the gyros off. And I am liking it!

The transmitter is quite nice for the price of this machine. Decent quality.

To date, I have seven flights on it and now have a total of 5 batteries that will fit. It is a unique size for 850 – 1000 mah lipos.
